Since January 1956 he has Commanded the 1st Division and recently, in addition to the Division, he has Commanded Salisbury Plain District. In spite of the fact that his Division has been very weak and the normal opportunities for training his Division have not existed, he has taken the initiative in starting a number of most valuable Military Studies and experiments. The most important of these studies has shown the way to a much lighter and more mobile fighting force. Other studies have covered an improved and more practical method of M.T. Maintenance. And yet another has shown how M.T. Accounting can be vastly simplified. These have been most valuable contributions to military thought at the present time.

This officer's outstanding and infectious enthusiasm deserve acknowledgement and encouragement. I most strongly recommend him for a C.B..
